Path	Length (Miles)	From	To	Comments
02	0.05	Manor Farm (Stapleton) on the Long Load road	Milton Lane (Stapleton)	A short path across fields.
03	0.66	Long Load road	Coat	A 3 legged path, across fields. The length is the sum of the 3 legs
07	0.88	Pound Lane (By the church)	The Old Post Office (Coat Road),	This path runs across fields.
08	0.32	Coat House	Join Path 07 at Grey Stone Drove	Across fields, some grazed.
10	1.04	Elm Lane (Coat)	Pound Lane/Martock Church	Across fields, some grazed.
11	1.17	Gawbridge Bow (Jenny's Bridge)	Hurst Bow (Yandles Timber)	Across fields, some grazed.
12	0.60	Stapleton Road Allotments	Highway Farm Ash (Vickerys)	Through fields.
13	0.61	Ash recreation ground	Foldhill Lane (Taepner Court)	Starts as Y1-14 - in Ash Parish and is mainly through fields. The length is the sum of both.
14	0.26	Steppes Crescent	Triways	Mainly along field edges.
15	0.23	Triways	East Street Drove	Mainly along field edges.
15A	0.56	Foldhill Lane (Site of Bearley Bridge)	North end of Venn Lane (Venn Bridge Farm)	Through fields and along farm tracks.
16	0.62	Foldhill Lane (Foldhill Farm [Tintinhull])	A303 (Venn Bridge Farm)	A public bridleway since 2007
17	0.52	Church/Water Street	Stoke Road	By the stream and through grazed fields.
17A	0.26	East Street (Madey Mill Cottage)	Stoke Road	Through grazed fields.
18	0.77	Madey Mill	A303 (Venn Bridge)	Beside the mill stream and through mainly grazed fields.
19	0.16	Path 17 between WP 3 & 4	East Street (East of the Post Office)	This short path is mainly through an orchard.
20	0.90	Stoke Road (Nigel Day's Yard)	A303	Across fields
21	0.54	Water Street via Hoop Lane	Lovers Grove (Hurst)	Across the recreation ground and woods, into a grazed field.
21PP	0.32	Hoop Lane	Dim mock's Lane	This is a Permissive Path between Y16-21 and Y16-32, beside the rugby and cricket fields.
22	1.15	Bower Hinton	Stoke Road	This is part of the Parrett Trail, across farmland and farm tracks.
23	0.23	Dim mock's Lane (Bower Hinton)	Sparrow Works (Bower Hinton)	Across fields, mainly grazed by horses.
24	0.71	Gaston's Lane (Bower Hinton)	Parrett Works	The start of this path is also the start of Y16-25A. Mainly across grazed fields.
24A	0.66	South Petherton Road (By Hills Farm entrance)	Bower Hinton Shop (Broad Lane)	A gentle walk along farm tracks. The middle part can be very muddy in winter.
25	0.90	Ringwell Hill (Bower Hinton)	Target Lane (Bower Hinton Farm)	Mainly along farm tracks.
25A	0.54	Gaston's Lane (Bower Hinton)	Target Lane (Bower Hinton Farm)	The start of this path is also the start of Y16-24. Mainly across grazed fields.
25PP	0.18	Gaston's Lane (Bower Hinton)	Cripple Hill (Bower Hinton Farm)	This is a Permissive Path, across farmland, between Y16-25 and Y16-25A
26	0.78	Bulsom Bridge via Target Lane	A303	Mainly along a wooded track that can be very muddy in winter.
27	0.57	Hallet's Lane (Bower Hinton Farm)	Target Lane (Bower Hinton Farm)	A gentle path through farmland, with some spectacular views to the south.
28	1.43	Gawbridge Bow	Kingsbury Episcopi	Mainly through arable fields, by the river. Length is the sum of the 2 parts.
29	0.05	Parrett Works/Carey's Mill Bridge	Westward to Y24/66	Length is only of the Martock part.
30	0.17	Old Cricket Ground	Mill Brook	A short path along fields edges.

31	0.32	Hill's Lane (RUPP)	Y16-31	Starting between houses, goes into grazed fields.
32	0.28	Dim mock's Lane (Bower Hinton)	Lane's end (Bower Hinton)	A Restricted Byway
33	0.43	Parrett Works	Broad Lane (Bower Hinton)	Across usually arable fields
34	0.35	Hills Farm	Y16-07 (Pound Lane to Coat Road)	Across grazed fields
35	0.59	Bower Hinton (Talbot's Yard)	Y16-20	Mainly across grazed fields
36	0.46	East Street Drove	Venn Lane	This was declared a bridleway on 31 January 2003.
37	0.47	Y16-14 - along Gildings Drove	Y16-12	This Drove is a wide path that was designated as a footpath in May 2005.
