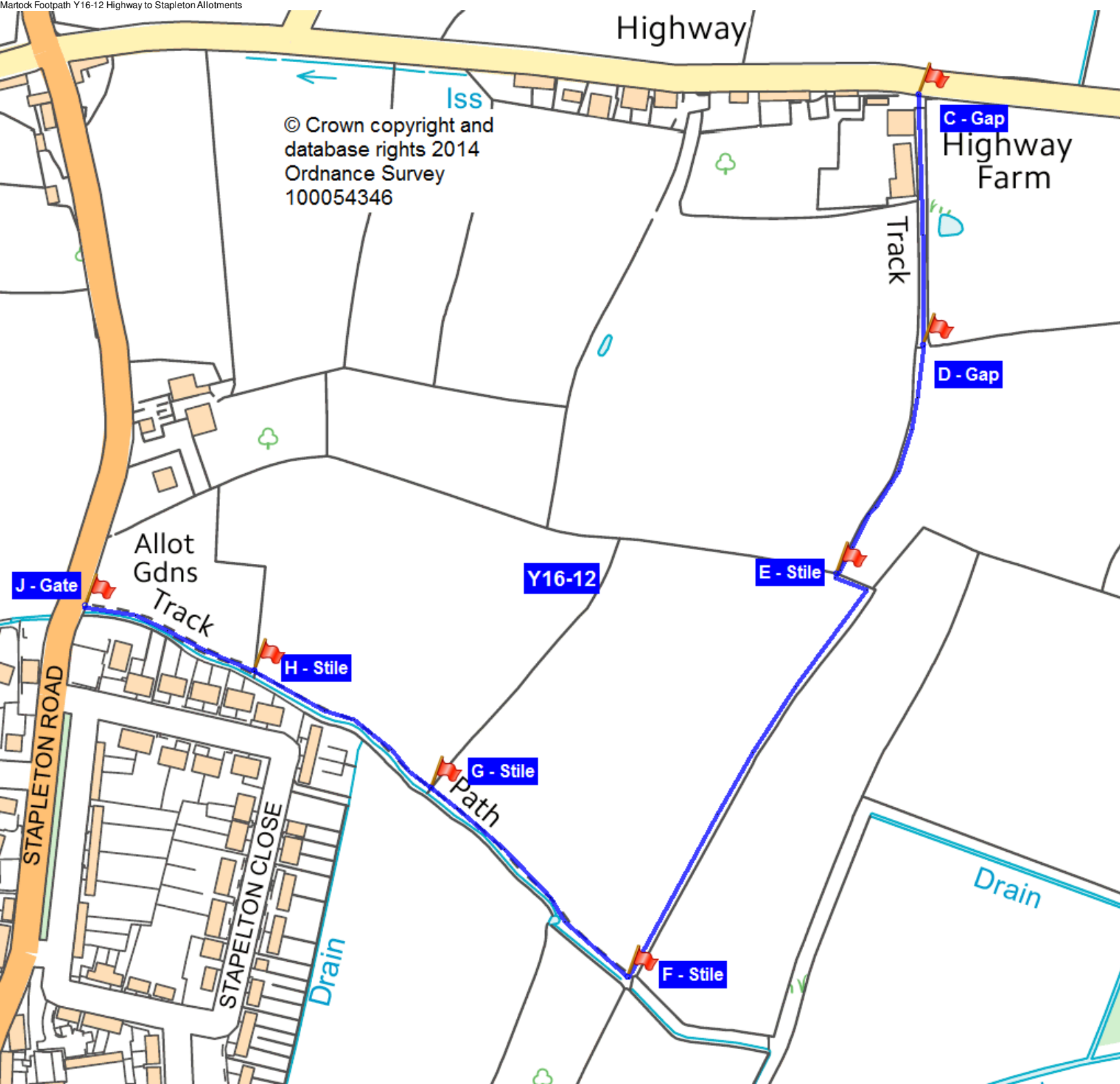




Martock Footpath Y16- 12

This path runs from Stapleton Road Allotments to Highway Farm Ash (Vickery's)

This path length (in miles) is 0.599

A gentle walk alongside the allotments and then through fields - occasionally grazed.

Waypoint C. (OS Grid Ref: ST 46822 20796)

At Highway's Farm/Vickery's, in Ash parish.

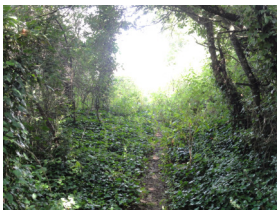

The path starts here, at the road. From WP C to WP D the path runs S along a track from the road, initially beside a Vickery's building and then through an overgrown glade.

Waypoint D. (OS Grid Ref: ST 46825 20651)

In Ash parish. There is no stile or fence here - but methinks there was one once.

From WP D to WP E, the path runs along the W side of this sometimes arable field.

Waypoint E. (OS Grid Ref: ST 46775 20519)

This waypoint is at the boundary of Martock & Ash. There is a new (2014) kissing gate and a 6 sleeper bridge over the adjacent ditch. Needs cutting back from time to time Brambles etc..

From WP E to WP F the path runs along the E side of this sometimes arable, sometimes grazed field.

Martock Footpath Y16- 12

This path runs from Stapleton Road Allotments to Highway Farm Ash (Vickery's)

This path length (in miles) is 0.599

A gentle walk alongside the allotments and then through fields - occasionally grazed.

Waypoint F. (OS Grid Ref: ST 46654 20286)

This point on Y16-12, is now also the start and finish of Y16-37. There is a (usually padlocked) steel gate here. Adjacent to it is good pedestrian access to Y16-37, via a new (2014) kissing gate.

From WP F to WP G the path continues along the S edge of this same field.

Waypoint G. (OS Grid Ref: ST 46540 20396)

This is now (2014) a handsome steel kissing gate and a 3 sleeper bridge. Beware of the barbed wire in the adjacent fence. It needs to be cleared of brambles from time to time and gets very muddy in winter, with slippery climbs on both sides.

From WP G to WP H the path skirts the S perimeter of this often grazed meadow with grass underfoot.

Waypoint H. (OS Grid Ref: ST 46438 20464)

There is a new (2014) Bristol gate here, alongside the old pipe stile. Beware the barbed wire on the adjacent fence. It needs clearing of brambles from time to time.

From WP H to WP J there is a wide path through the allotments, where dogs are required to be kept on a lead.

Waypoint J. (OS Grid Ref: ST 46340 20501)

At Stapleton Road, at the entrance to the allotments, there are two gates to the path. A large one for vehicles and a small one for pedestrians. There is a new (2014) wooden fingerpost "Public footpath" and yellow Arrow.
