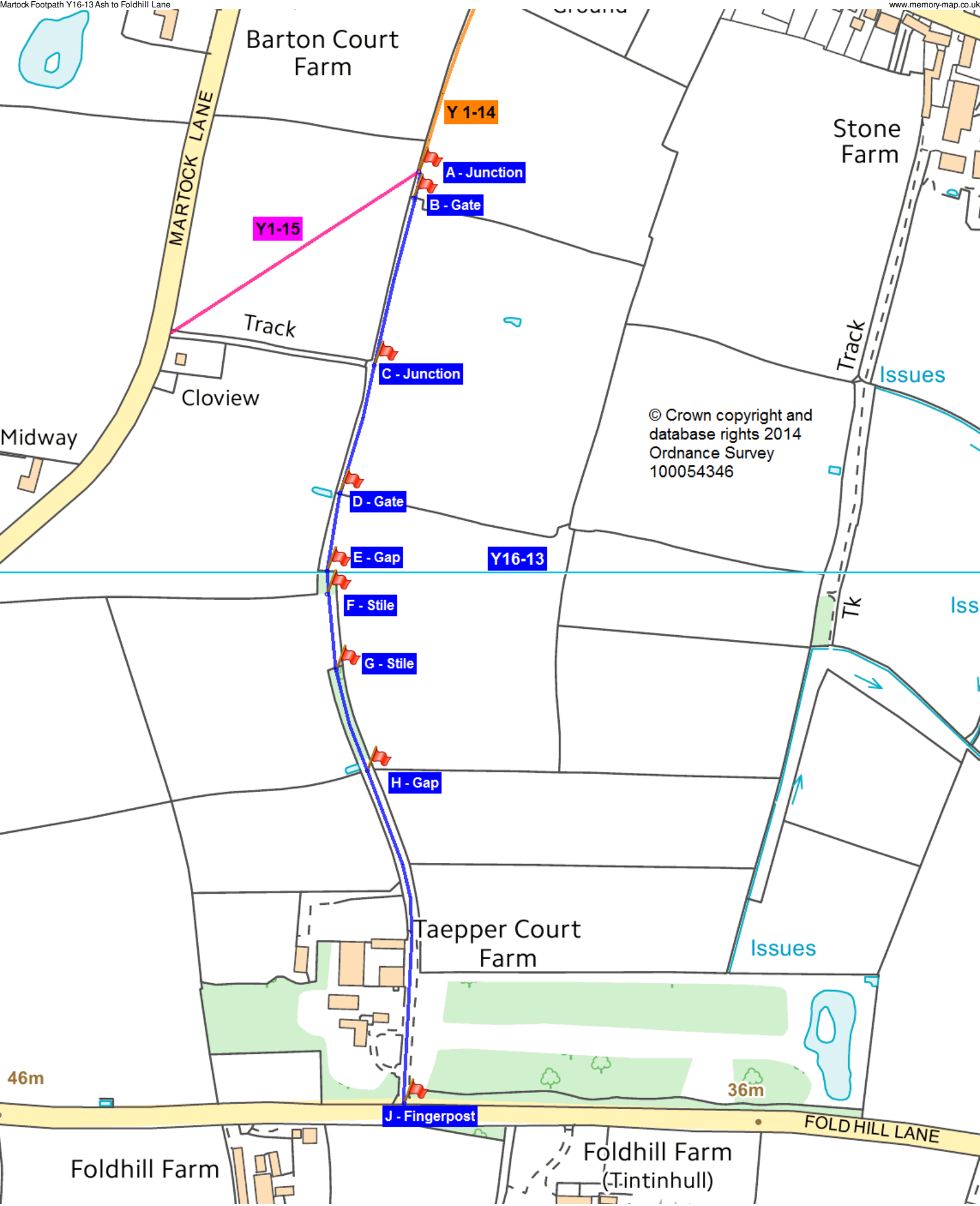




Martock Footpath Y16- 13

This path runs from Ash recreation ground to Foldhill Lane (Taepper Court)

This path length (in miles) is 0.612

Starts as Y1-14 - in Ash Parish - and is mainly through fields. There are a few stiles. The length is the sum of both sections.

Waypoint A. (OS Grid Ref: ST 47513 20297)

This waypoint is at the junction of: Y1-14 (from the N), Y1-15 (from the W) and Y16-13 (heading S). Y16-13 takes over from Y1-14 and is alongside the junction with Y1-15 from the W. Y1-15 has a 2 sleeper bridge over the ditch, a steel kissing gate (was a wooden stile) and a stone stile just as it joins Y1-14 and Y16-13.

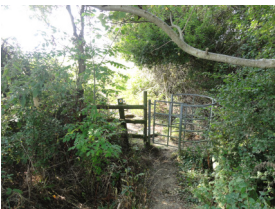

The Y16 part of the path starts here and heads S the short distance to the edge of the field, which is sometimes grazed.

Waypoint B. (OS Grid Ref: ST 47509 20277)

A fairly new (2012) steel kissing gate

From WP B to WP D the path follows the W perimeter of this often grazed field.

Waypoint C. (OS Grid Ref: ST 47480 20154)

Merely a waypoint marking the end of the drove to the W (marked by an old rusty gate hidden in the brambles): which drove is totally overgrown and probably has been for years.

From WP C to WP D the path continues along the W perimeter of this often grazed field.

Martock Footpath Y16- 13

This path runs from Ash recreation ground to Foldhill Lane (Taepper Court)

This path length (in miles) is 0.612

Starts as Y1-14 - in Ash Parish - and is mainly through fields. There are a few stiles. The length is the sum of both sections.

Waypoint D. (OS Grid Ref: ST 47454 20059)

The S boundary of this field comprises a thick hedge, fenced on both sides by large wire mesh netting. If there ever was a stile here it is no longer evident and the only way through is via a steel 5 barred gate some 10 metres from the western extremity of the field.

From WP D to WP E the pathway continues in a direct line from gate to stile at WP E. The field is sometimes grazed and sometimes arable.

Waypoint E. (OS Grid Ref: ST 47444 20002)

There was (2013) a wooden stile here but it is now demolished and it and the associated wire lies forlornly to the E side of a gap - often muddy. Needs cutting back from time to time.

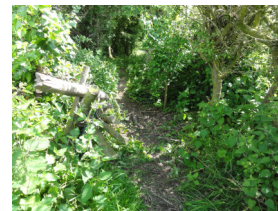

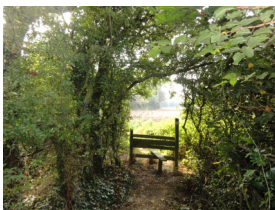

Waypoint F. (OS Grid Ref: ST 47444 19985)

A wooden 3 horizontal and 1 step stile with barbed wire either side.

From WP F to WP G the pathway skirts the E perimeter of this field that is usually arable.

Martock Footpath Y16- 13

This path runs from Ash recreation ground to Foldhill Lane (Taepper Court)

This path length (in miles) is 0.612

Starts as Y1-14 - in Ash Parish - and is mainly through fields. There are a few stiles. The length is the sum of both sections.

Waypoint G. (OS Grid Ref: ST 47451 19929)

A wooden 3 horizontals and 1 step stile, with an old rusty gate alongside.

From WP G to WP H is a "wooded glade" which needs cutting back overhead now and then.

Waypoint H. (OS Grid Ref: ST 47474 19854)

Where the track passes the field edge.

The path ends where the track meets Foldhill Lane. There is a wooden signpost "Public Footpath - Ash 3/4 mile"
