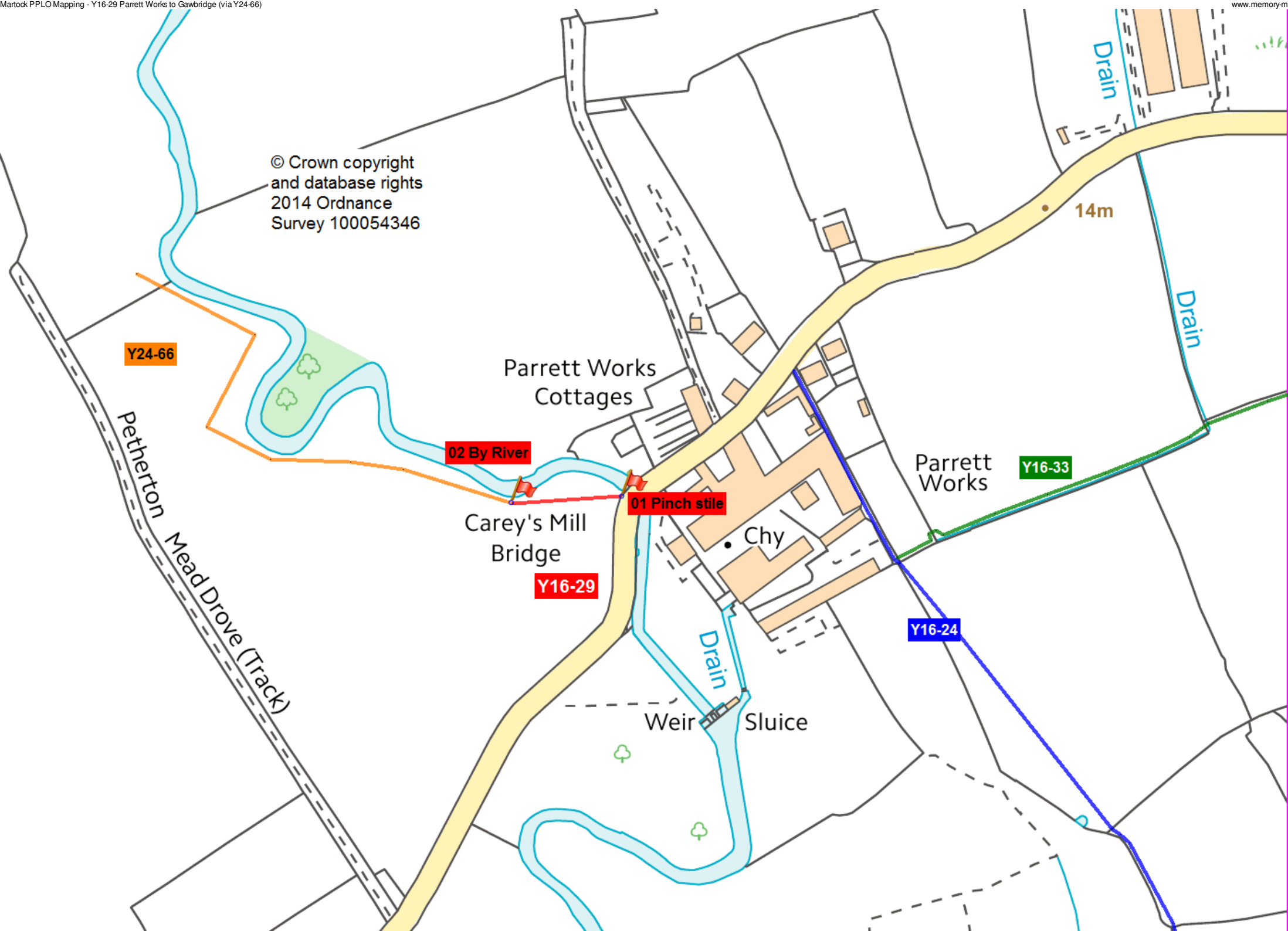




Martock Footpath Y16- 29

This path runs from Parrett Works/Carey's Mill Bridge, westward to to Y24/66

This path length (in miles) is 0.045

This is a very short, level path is across a field, usually arable. The length is only that of the Martock part.

Waypoint 01. (OS Grid Ref: ST 44541 18659)

This is a hamstone pinch stile through the wall from the road into the field. Transit through it has been made easier (2014) by a step on the W side that raises the traveller up to the wider part of the "pinch". The hedge to the W has been strengthened with barbed wire although gaps are present for dog access. In extremis, there is a gate some 200 yards down, at the end of the field.

On the bridge parapet to the west of WP 01 there is an iron disc with an embossed design - about 10" in diameter. No idea what it is - but any walker who does know, could perhaps inform the Market House or Parish Footpath officer.

From WP 01 to WP 02 is a walk W, across a pleasant meadow, to an imaginary point that is the start of Y24-66.

Waypoint 02. (OS Grid Ref: ST 44464 18655)

This imaginary point, some 100 yards from WP 01, is the end of this path and the start of Y24-66.
