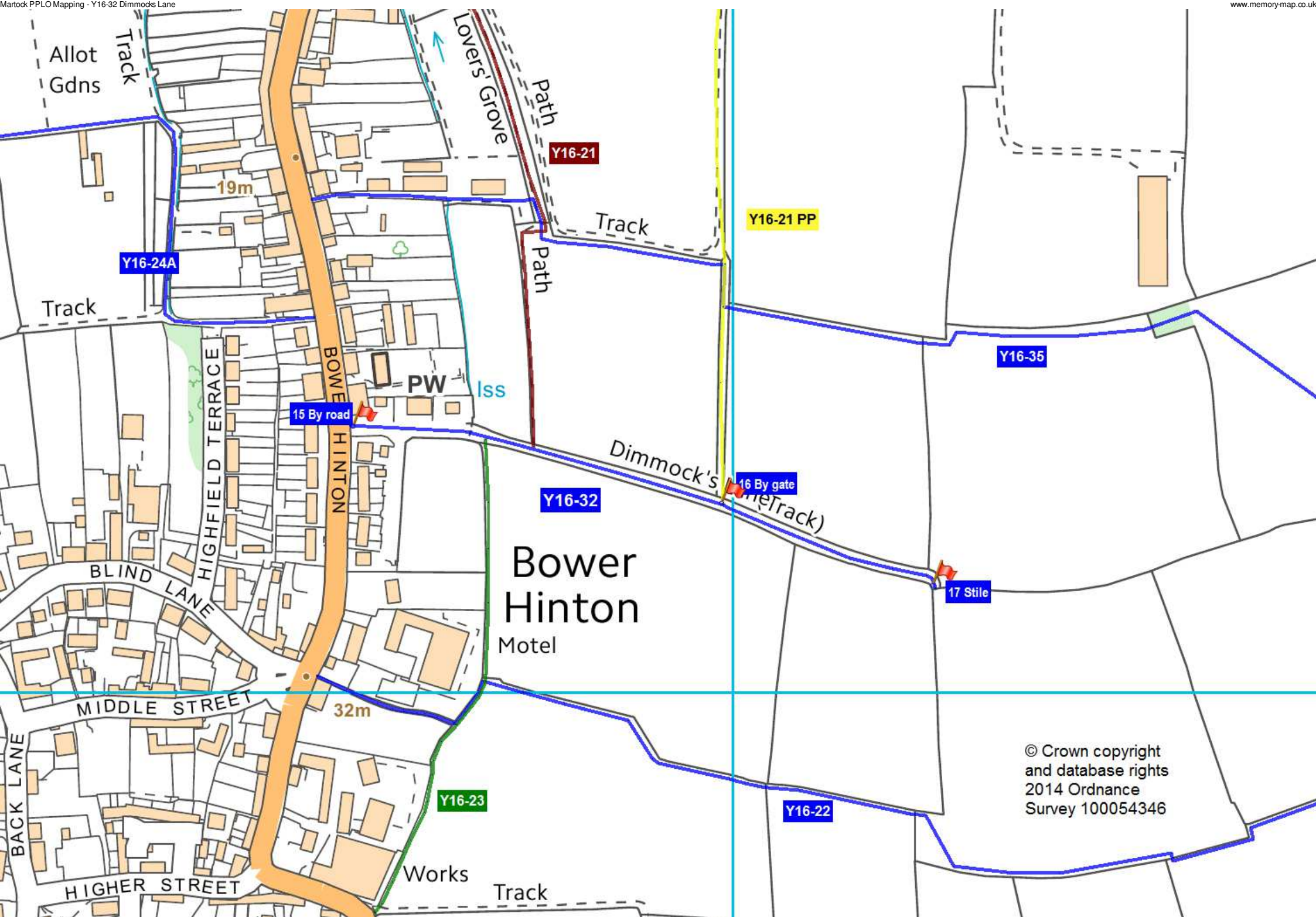




Martock Footpath Y16- 32

This path runs from Dimmock's Lane (Bower Hinton) to Lane's end (Bower Hinton)

This path length (in miles) is 0.278

This level path is a Restricted Byway. It can be muddy in parts at any time and very muddy throughout in winter.

Waypoint 15. (OS Grid Ref: ST 45723 18195)

The path starts at the Bower Hinton road where there was a fingerpost.

From WP 15 to WP 16 there is a good wide lane, the W part is tarmac, gradually diminishing in underfoot quality to become a grassy track of sufficient width to accommodate agricultural machinery. At times it gets very overgrown and narrows.

Waypoint 16. (OS Grid Ref: ST 45991 18139)

A large steel gate, plus - by the side - a steel kissing gate. These provide access to the path to the north (Y16-21PP - Donated to Martock Parish Council), which leads to the extension to the Stoke Road Recreation Ground.

From WP 16 to WP 17 the path continues along a drove - but one may ask why, as it doesn't go anywhere? Access to the fields at the end is possible from other directions - but note, not via a formal footpath.

Waypoint 17. (OS Grid Ref: ST 46145 18080)

Dimmock's Lane ends here as does this path. At this point access (albeit, very basic and unofficial) is possible to all fields there.
