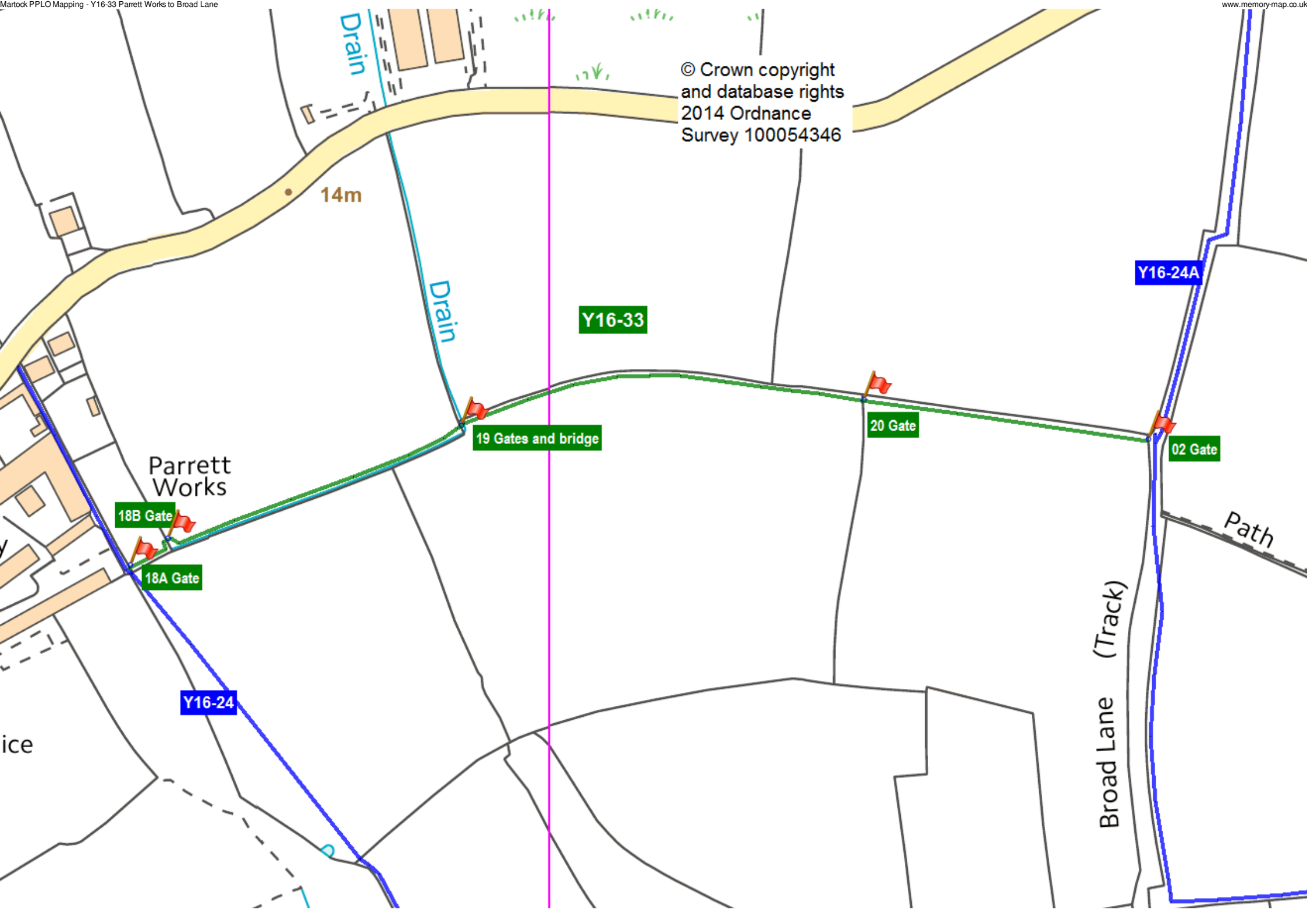




# Martock Footpath Y16- 33

**This path runs from Parrett Works to Broad Lane (Bower Hinton)**

**This path length (in miles) is 0.427**

*This level path runs across fields that are usually arable.*

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## Waypoint 18. (OS Grid Ref: )

Two wooden stiles here, close together (one on each side of an old ditch?). Both in good condition, with good dog access and with arrows.

12/7/09 Stiles replaced by wooden kissing gates.

From WP 18 to WP 19, the path keeps to the southern edge of the field (usually crops).

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## Waypoint 18A. (OS Grid Ref: ST 44731 18619)

There are now 2 new wooden kissing gates, about 20 yards apart - I have named them A (to the west) and B (to the east).

Note that Y16-24 WP 18A is next to Y16-24 WP 16.

From WP 18A to WP 18B, the path runs east between two fences/the two fields, for about 20 yards, with sharp left and then right kinks in it just before WP 18B. It gets overgrown with brambles and nettles regularly.

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## Waypoint 18B. (OS Grid Ref: ST 44755 18636)

There are now 2 new wooden kissing gates, about 20 yards apart - I have named them A (to the west) and B (to the east).

From WP 18B to WP 19, the path keeps to the southern edge of the field (usually crops).

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## Waypoint 19. (OS Grid Ref: ST 44943 18708)

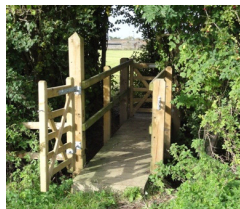
A stone bridge has been replaced by a wooden bridge with wooden gates at each end.

From WP 19 to WP 20 the path keeps to the northern edge of the field; usually crops

# Martock Footpath Y16- 33

**This path runs from Parrett Works to Broad Lane (Bower Hinton)**

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## Waypoint 20. (OS Grid Ref: ST 45201 18724)

Twin metal gates between the 2 fields, sometimes locked, with a metal pedestrian gate at the southern side of the gap.

From WP 20 to WP 02 (!) the path again keeps to the northern edge of the field; usually crops.

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## Waypoint 02. (OS Grid Ref: ST 45383 18699)

A Bristol gate has supplemented a wooden stile, the remains of which are at the southern edge of the gap.
