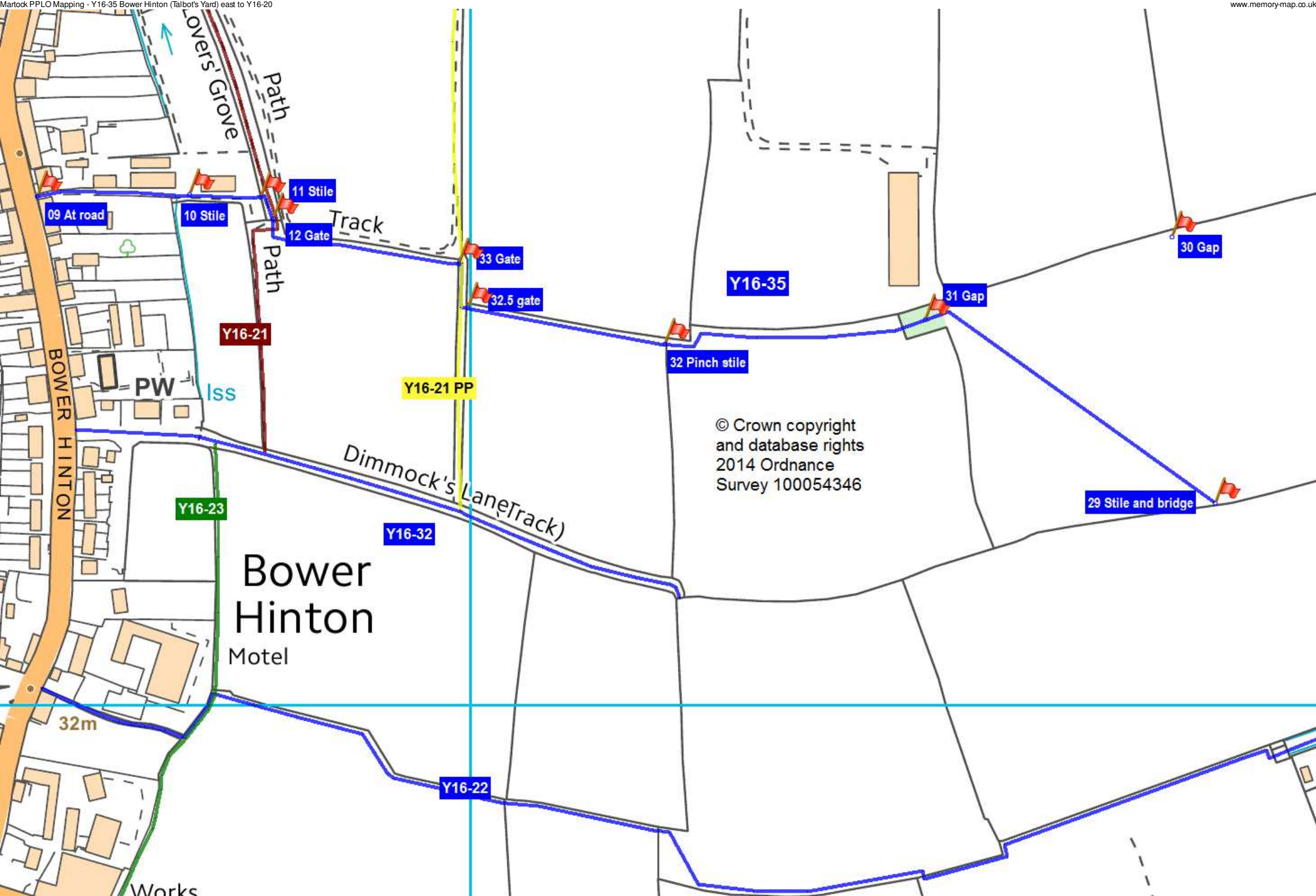




Martock Footpath Y16- 35

This path runs from Bower Hinton (Talbot's Yard) to Y16-20

This path length (in miles) is 0.585

This level path is across mainly grazed fields. It includes a few stiles, some of which are not dog friendly.

Waypoint 29. (OS Grid Ref: ST 46525 18144)

This is the same as Y16-20 WP 04. The stile here comprises horizontal steel bars with concrete posts and a stone step. Adjacent to it is a 2 sleeper bridge over quite a deep ditch. From time to time the brambles etc. needs cutting back.

From WP 29 to WP 31, at the NW corner of the field, the diagonal path across this field (usually crops, sometimes grazed by sheep) is very rarely evident. Sometimes the path Y16-20, that runs due N from WP 29, can be seen and that, plus the N headland, takes one to WP 31.

Waypoint 31. (OS Grid Ref: ST 46320 18273)

This is where a wide access track passes through a small copse. There is no fence or gate.

From WP 31 to WP 32 is a pathway along the N edge of the field (usually crops and sometimes grazed by sheep).

Waypoint 32. (OS Grid Ref: ST 46136 18256)

A stone (pedestrian) bridge crosses the ditch at this point and adjacent to it is an old hamstone pinch stile that has collapsed (a long time ago!) - so one just walks round it.

From WP 32 to WP 32.5 the pathway continues along the N edge of the field (usually crops but sometimes grazed by sheep).

Martock Footpath Y16- 35

This path runs from Bower Hinton (Talbot's Yard) to Y16-20

This path length (in miles) is 0.585

This level path is across mainly grazed fields. It includes a few stiles, some of which are not dog friendly.

Waypoint 32.5. (OS Grid Ref: ST 45997 18282)

A steel kissing gate(2005) here, in a post and rail fence bordering the access lane, which runs from Dimmock's Lane to the south end of the Recreation Ground.

From WP 32.5 to WP 33 the path runs a short distance N, along the Y16-21PP track, almost to the edge of the "new" recreation ground extension.

Waypoint 33. (OS Grid Ref: ST 45991 18313)

In 2013 a steel kissing gate was put in here, with a wooden fence to the sides.

Waypoint 12. (OS Grid Ref: ST 45860 18344)

An old steel kissing gate. The area beyond the gate is usually muddy.

Waypoint 11. (OS Grid Ref: ST 45851 18360)

A 4 metal horizontals and 2 steel steps stile over a steel fence.

The path heads W and passes through Talbots yard, in which there are usually a number of old vehicles.

Martock Footpath Y16- 35

Waypoint 10. (OS Grid Ref: ST 45801 18362)

(In Talbots Yard) Another metal stile - 4 metal horizontals and 2 steel steps -over a steel fence, with an adjacent gate (usually locked).

The path continues alongside the yard where there are usually several large and excitable dogs - walkers should be prepared to take evasive action on the way out to the road.

Waypoint 09. (OS Grid Ref: ST 45694 18360)

Steel fingerpost "Public Footpath" at the road used to show the start of this path but now (2013) it is just a post - the finger has vanished.
