So, we hope to see lots of sunflowers throughout the village this year. We have also included a number of classes which are designed to give this year's Show a sunflower theme.

We would like to thank all of the businesses who place advertisements in this programme for their support. We also take this opportunity to thank everyone who participates in or helps with the running of the Show for taking part. The success of the Show is dependent on community involvement.

As well as organising the Show, our group has an interesting programme of talks and garden visits throughout the year. How to Enter the Show

To enter the Show you just need to send an e-mail to:

with details of your name and a contact telephone number. You should state clearly which class or classes you wish to enter. We will acknowledge all entries to validate your entry. Please contact us by telephone or text on one of our helpline numbers below if you have not received an acknowledgment.

If you do not have access to a computer or need help in submitting an entry online please contact us on one of our telephone helpline numbers and we will help you to submit your entry.

All entries are free.

Rules

1. All entries must be submitted by midnight on Thursday 22nd August.
2. All entries must be staged at Martock Parish Hall between 6.30pm and 8pm on Friday 23rd August or between 9am and 10am on Saturday 24th August.
3. All exhibits must have been grown or made by the exhibitor except in the flower arranging classes.
4. Pot plants must have been in the possession of the exhibitor for at least 3 months.
5. An exhibitor may only exhibit one entry in each class.
6. Points for deciding awards will be calculated on the basis of 3 points for 1st prize, 2 points for 2nd prize and 1 point for 3rd prize. In the event of a points tie the exhibitor with the most first prizes will win the trophy.
7. The Show Secretary's decision is final on all matters

Helpful Hints for Flowers, Fruit & Vegetables

Quality, beauty and appearance are foremost. Lusciousness, radiance, freshness, size and uniformity make a big impact on the judge. Only if there are equally good exhibits in the same class does the presence of bent petals, spots and scars affect your chances.

Good presentation always helps. Three beetroot with carefully washed skins, or a bunch of sweet peas elegantly arranged and composed in a pretty vase will be awarded more points than an entry that is all bashed up and bruised.

It is all common sense but please ring Fergus Dowding on 07517 034533 if you feel you would like to clear up any uncertainties. Always worth checking.

Classes for children under age 12 at the date of the Show

3. Largest sunflower head (with or without petals)
4. A painting or drawing of a sunflower

All other classes in the Show are open to everyone regardless of age

Craft Classes

5. Anything made principally from wood
6. Anything made principally from metal
7. An item of pottery or clay
8. A craft item made from any other one material or mixture of materials
9. An item of knitting or crochet
10. An item of any other needlecraft (not knitting or crochet)
11. A home-made greetings card (maximum size A5)
12. A painting or drawing of a sunflower

Photography Classes

No mountings please (maximum size A5)

13. A photo of a sunflower or sunflowers
14. A photo of a garden
15. A photo of an insect
16. A photo of a bird
17. A photo of any other animal (not a bird or insect)
18. A photo of a landscape in Somerset

19. 3 dahlias (same variety)
